Pastoral Voice

Dearly beloved saints of CERC,

"O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods." Psalm 95: 1-3

May we come this morning with joyful and grateful hearts to worship our great God, Who is the rock of our salvation, the King of kings and the Lord of lords.

December is the busiest month for our Church. Many activities are being organized. We thank God for the Vacation Bible School (VBS) which is open to children between ages 5 to 12. A total of 8 children will be joining the VBS of whom 2 are relatives of our Church members. Do pray for the attendees and those who are involved in this work. The CK/CKS Camp is the highlight of the CK/CKS activities. Pray for the Lord's blessings on the youths as they learn about "Contentment as Covenant Youths". Do take the golden opportunity to invite your loved ones/friends to hear "The Wise Men's Christmas" as we commemorate the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Come 1st Jan 2019, we will be having our Church Retreat where Prof Cammenga will launch the new Church theme: "Keeping the Unity of the Spirit (Eph 4: 1 - 3)".

Elder Leong and Deacon Lee will be making a trip to the Philippines from 15 Dec to 20 Dec 2018 to explore the possibility of having a sister church relationship with the Protestant Reformed Churches in the Philippines (PRCP). They have been mandated by the Session to: 1. Confirm the unity that we have; 2. Discuss CERC's and PRCP's current church relationships and plans (if any) in seeking church relationships with other churches; 3. Gain familiarity with each other; and 4. Discuss the process of establishing the sister church relationship.

The PRCP comprises 3 churches, namely Berean Protestant Reformed Church (BPRC) in, Antipolo, Rizal; the Protestant Reformed Church in Bulacan (PRCB) in Muzon, San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan; and the Maranatha Protestant Reformed Church (MPRC) in Valenzuela. The BPRC has Rev. Vernon Ibe as its pastor and has a membership of 28 families. The PRCB has Rev. John Flores as its pastor and has a membership of 19 families while MPRC is pastored by Rev. Leovino Trinidad and has a membership of 13 families. For your information, Rev Leovino Trinidad is the father of our brother Jun Trinidad.

Another congregation, the Provident Christian Church in Marikina City which is being mentored by Rev Daniel Holstege, has indicated its desire to be a member of PRCP. Presently, PRCP has adopted the Protestant Reformed Fellowship in Albuera, Leyte (IPRFA) as its first official Mission field. PRCP has also established a sister relationship with the PRCA recently and is currently working with PRCA in establishing a Protestant Reformed Seminary as well as a Christian school in Philippines.

Do pray for the labours of Elder Leong and Deacon Lee.
